Prosecution's Request

1. The Prosecution was informed that Prosecution Witness P-0877, who is due to testify during the fourth week of June 2016, was admitted as a victim¹ in a representative capacity on behalf of a former child soldier, who has also been admitted to participate in these proceedings.
2. With a view to discharging its disclosure obligations pursuant to rule 76 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Prosecution requests access, on an *ex parte*, Prosecution and Legal Representative of the former child soldiers only, basis to the victim application form of Witness P-0877, in its long version.
3. Having obtained access to this document, the Prosecution will apply any necessary redactions, disclose it to the Defence and transmit the redacted form to the Registry for uploading into eCourt, which will provide the Chamber, Parties and participants access to it.
