Introduction

1. The Registry informs the Chamber of the appointment of Mr Cyril Laucci as Legal Adviser to Witness P-0190 ("Notification of Appointment"), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the "Rules").

Classification

1. Annex I is classified as confidential, pursuant to regulation 23bis(1) Regulations of the Court ("RoC"), as it contains the private contact details of Mr Laucci.

Applicable Law

2. This Notification of Appointment is based on article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74(10) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (the "Code").

Submissions

3. On 16 May 2016, the Registrar appointed Mr Cyril Laucci as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-0190, pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules.¹
4. Mr Laucci was duly provided with electronic access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-0190, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain due respect for confidentiality at all times.²
5. On 16 May 2016, Mr Laucci has executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.³
