I. Introduction

1. The present filing is submitted to register the items of evidence recognised by Trial Chamber VII (the “Trial Chamber”) as formally submitted.

I. Procedural History

2. On 29 April 2016, the Trial Chamber issued its Decision on Outstanding Evidentiary Applications (the “Decision”).¹
3. In the Decision, the Trial Chamber recognised as formally submitted certain items of evidence presented by the parties as follows:

“(...) the documents indicated in Bemba Defence request ICC-01/05-01/13-1794-Corr-Red (subject to paragraph 12), Kilolo Defence request ICC-01/05-01/13-1797-Conf (subject to paragraph 17), Babala Defence request ICC-01/05-01/13-1781-Conf, Arido Defence request ICC-01/05-01/13-1789 (subject to paragraphs 30-31) and Bemba and Mangenda Defence request ICC-01/05-01/13-1831; ”

and

“ (...) the documents in Prosecution request ICC-01/05-01/13-1784-Red only to the extent specified in paragraph 50;”²

4. In addition, the Registry was ordered to ensure that the eCourt metadata reflected the items recognised as formally submitted to the Chamber.

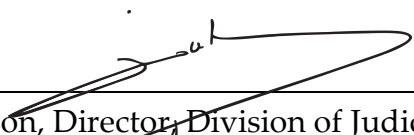
