1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits, in appended annexes to this filing, [REDACTED]¹ and [REDACTED] for five Prosecution witnesses at risk on account of their interaction with the Court in this case (“persons at risk”). These are witnesses CAR-OTP-PPPP-0015,² CAR-OTP-PPPP-0032,³ CAR-OTP-PPPP-0036,⁴ CAR-OTP-PPPP-0044⁵ and CAR-OTP-PPPP-0045⁶. The [REDACTED] has been shared with the Victims and Witnesses Unit (“VWU”), which provided input incorporated into the document.

2. The [REDACTED] summarizes the security situation in the Democratic Republic of the Congo, where all the aforesaid witnesses reside, while the [REDACTED] summarize the security situation of each individual witness. This information will enable the Chamber to be fully informed of the present level of risk as well as the measures in place to manage these foreseeable risks. The Prosecution undertakes to inform Trial Chamber III if significant changes are made to the [REDACTED].
