Introduction

1. The Registry informs Trial Chamber VIII (“the Chamber”) of the acknowledgement of the appointment of the Legal Representative of the Victims in the present case, and his execution of the undertakings required by the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (“Code”).

Applicable Law

2. This notification of appointment is based on rules 22 and 90 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 67, 69 and 80 of the Regulations of the Court, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 1, 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code.

Submissions

3.
