Introduction

1. The Registry informs the Chamber of the appointment of Mr Assane Dioma Ndiaye as Legal Adviser to Witness P-0321 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Rules”).

Applicable Law

2. This Notification of Appointment is based on article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74(10) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the Regulations of the Court, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (the “Code”).

Submissions

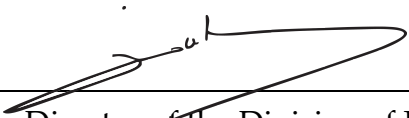
3. On 22 June 2016, the Registrar appointed Mr Assane Dioma Ndiaye as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-0321, pursuant to rule 74 of the Rules.¹
4. Mr Ndiaye was duly provided with electronic access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of interviews of Witness P-0321, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain due respect for confidentiality at all times.²
5. On 29 November 2012, Mr Ndiaye has executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.³
