I. Introduction

1. On 24 March 2016, Trial Chamber III ("Trial Chamber") issued the "Decision on "Requête relative à la reprise des actions introduites devant la Cour par des victimes décédées"" ("Decision"),¹ adopting a system of resumption of the actions initiated by deceased participating victims in the case of the *Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* ("Deceased Victims"), and ordering *inter alia* the Registry to transmit to the Trial Chamber complete applications for the resumption of actions of a Deceased Victim by family members or closely-connected individuals with relevant documents ("Application for Resumption of Actions").²

II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the Applications for Resumption of Actions and the Registry's report on their assessments ("Registry's Report") are submitted as annexes to the present filing with the status "Confidential EX PARTE", in accordance with the Decision.³

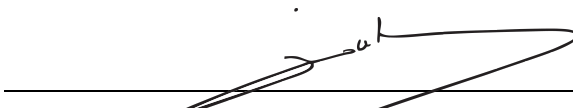
