3. Article 75(3) of the Rome Statute and rule 13 and 103 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

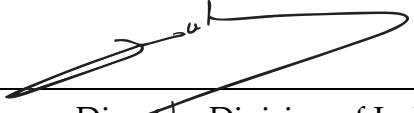
IV. Submission
