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I. Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits, in appended annex to this filing, the [REDACTED] for all persons at risk on account of their interaction with the Court (“persons at risk”) in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo*. [REDACTED].

2. The [REDACTED] summarizes for the Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) the security situation in the Central African Republic, the Democratic Republic of Congo, as well as other countries [REDACTED]. In case of significant changes in the assessment, the Prosecution undertakes to inform the Chamber.

3. The Prosecution is about to request an *Ex parte* Status Conference, Prosecution and VWU only, to present orally to the Chamber information obtained by the Prosecution and the VWU on the security situation of trial witnesses.

II. Request for Confidentiality

4. The Prosecution requests for the receipt of Annex A as “Confidential, *Ex Parte*, Prosecution and VWU only” as it relates to security of witnesses and includes information that is not known to the Defence, other parties and the public.
