1. On 23 September 2011, the Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submitted to Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) a [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] for five Prosecution witnesses at risk on account of their interaction with the Court in this case (“persons at risk”).¹ Further to its previous submission, the Prosecution hereby provides, in appended annexes to this filing, [REDACTED] for five additional persons at risk. 2. [REDACTED] of each individual witness. [REDACTED] the Chamber to be fully informed of the present level of risk as well as the measures in place to manage these foreseeable risks. The Prosecution undertakes to inform the Chamber of any significant changes to these [REDACTED].

3. The Prosecution requests that Annexes A to E be received by the Chamber as “Confidential, *Ex Parte*, Prosecution and Victims and Witnesses Unit only” as they relate to the [REDACTED] and include information that is not known to the Defence, other participants and the public.
