1. The Prosecution hereby submits its updated list of witnesses.
2. On 13 July 2016, Trial Chamber IX (“the Trial Chamber”) issued the Initial Directions on the Conduct of the Proceedings¹. Pursuant to these directions, on 6 September 2016 the Prosecution submitted its list of witnesses (“original list”).
3. In light of an omission in the original list of witnesses, and further instructions from the Trial Chamber,² the Prosecution submits its updated list of witnesses. In addition to the details that were provided in the original list, the updated version identifies the witnesses that will testify *via* video link, those whom the Prosecution intends to call pursuant to rule 68(3)³, and those categorised as experts. Moreover, the list has been amended so that Witness P-0218 will exchange places with P-0018 in the proposed order of appearance. P-0218 will now be the 27th witness to be called and P-0018 the 12th.

4. The Prosecution submits annex A as “Confidential” pursuant to regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court, because it contains information that is classified as confidential in the case record.
