Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) provides notice of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a),(b) of the Rome Statute, and rule 76(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Submission

2. On 22 November 2016, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence one package of evidence: Pre-trial INCR package 34 containing 64 items/1.585 pages. They are Acholi and English versions of the English only transcripts previously disclosed.

3. Additionally, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence six transcripts¹ of December 2015 interview of Witness P-0142. The Prosecution will file an application with the Chamber to add these transcripts to the List of Evidence.

4. Annex A attached to this communication contains the list of evidence that has been disclosed to the Defence. The Prosecution requests that this annex be received as “Confidential” since it relates to *inter partes* disclosure.
