I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby submits to Trial Chamber IX ("Chamber") an updated consolidated list of victims admitted to participate in the *Prosecutor v. Dominic Ongwen* ("Ongwen case") in Annex.

II. Procedural history

2. On 30 November 2016, the Registry submitted to the Chamber a consolidated list of victims admitted to participate in the *Ongwen* case.¹ In that list, it identified four participating victims whose representation was unclear.²
3. In his "Order Concerning Four Victim Applications" of 16 December 2016 ("Single Judge's Order"), the Single Judge:
 - i. noted that the Legal Representative of Victims and the Common Legal Representative of Victims were in agreement that the four victims should be represented by Mr Manoba and Mr Cox;
 - ii. agreed to retain the original reference numbers of the four applications; and
 - iii. ordered the Registry, *inter alia*, to file, as soon as is practicable, an updated consolidated list of victims admitted to participate in the present case which reflected the information contained in his order.³

III. Classification

4. Pursuant to regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations"), the annex to this document is submitted as "Confidential" since it contains sensitive information which may lead to the identification of the victims.

IV. Applicable Law

5. The Registry submits the present document in accordance with article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16, 85 and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 86 of the Regulations and regulations 105 to 109 and 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and in accordance with the Single Judge's Order.

V. Submission

6. The Registry hereby submits, in the annex attached to this document, an updated consolidated list of the 4,107 victims admitted to participate in the instant case, out of which 2,605 victims are represented by the Legal Representative of Victims (Messrs Manoba and Cox) and 1,502 victims are represented by the Common Legal Representative of Victims (Ms Paolina Massidda).
