II - Applicable Law

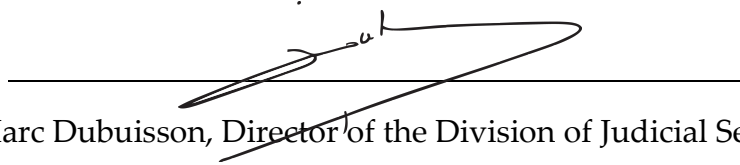
