I - Introduction

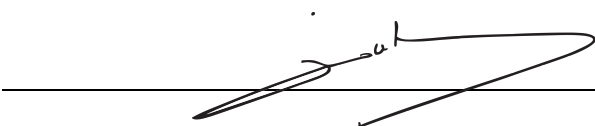
IV - Submissions
