Introduction

1. The Registry informs the Chamber of the appointment of Mr. Fabián Raimondo as Legal Adviser to Witness P-0264 (“Notification of Appointment”), pursuant to rule 74(10) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), in substitution of the previous appointed Counsel, Mr. Emile Aoun.

Classification

2. The present submission is classified public and annexes are classified confidential, pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), because they contain the identity or private contact details of Mr. Fabián Raimondo.

Applicable Law

3. The Registry has considered the following provisions: article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 74(10) of the Rules, regulations 67 and 69 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel (“Code”).

Submission

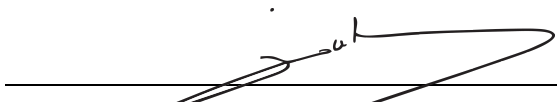
4. On 23 March 2017, the Registrar appointed Mr. Fabián Raimondo as the Legal Adviser to Witness P-0264.¹
5. Ms Raimondo was duly provided with electronic access to relevant material in connection with the case, including the statements and transcripts of

interviews of Witness P-0264, *via* a secure channel in order to maintain confidentiality at all times.²

6. On 15 September 2011, Mr Raimondo executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.³
