1. On 9 June 2016, the Defence for Mr Narcisse Arido submitted a “Request for an Effective Remedy in Light of Two Austrian Decisions” (“the Request”).¹ The Defence requests Trial Court VII to, *inter alia*, reconsider the decision in which it rejects the requests of the Defence teams to exclude Western Union documents admitted as evidence.²
