I. BRIEF PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

1. On 19 October 2016, Trial Chamber VII (“Chamber”) pronounced its Judgment pursuant to article 74 of the Statute, convicting Mr Aimé Kilolo.¹ On the same day, the Chamber ruled that Mr Kilolo should remain on interim release.²

2. On 20 October 2016, the Chamber issued an order setting the Sentencing Calendar.³ The order included instructions to the Parties to provide, by 4 November 2016, the list of witnesses they anticipated calling for the purpose of sentencing and summaries of their anticipated testimonies.⁴

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

3. In accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court, Annexes A and B appended hereto are marked confidential as they contain information which should not be revealed to the public.

III. SUBMISSION OF THE LIST OF WITNESSES

4. The Defence for Mr Kilolo hereby informs the Chamber and the Parties that it anticipates calling seven witnesses. Details about the appearance of witnesses such as the code, identities of witnesses and anticipated lengths of the Defence’s examination-in-chief are contained in Annex A. Annex B contains the summary of their anticipated testimonies.
