I. Introduction

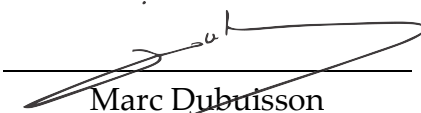
1. This report is submitted in implementation of the “Decision inviting the Republic of Chad to provide submissions concerning its failure to arrest Omar Al-Bashir and surrender him to the Court” (“Decision”) issued by Pre-Trial Chamber II on 13 December 2017.¹ The authorities of Chad were invited to provide their submissions by 22 January 2018.

II. Classification

2. Pursuant to regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the Annex to this submission is classified as confidential because it refers to individual staff members of the International Criminal Court.

III. Submissions

3. On 19 December 2017, the Registry transmitted the Decision both in its original language and French translation to the authorities of Chad. The note verbale transmitting the Decision and the memorandum of notification are annexed to this submission.
4. To date, the Registry has received no reply from the authorities of Chad.
