Procedural Background

1. On 31 July 2017, the Prosecution filed its application for the introduction of video evidence (“the Original Request”).¹
2. On 19 January 2018, the Prosecution filed an application for leave to reply to the Defence responses to its Original Request. In this application, the Prosecution sought to clarify its Original Request on certain issues of substance.² On 2 February 2018, the Chamber rejected the application (“Chamber’s Decision”) and noted that an application for leave to reply to a response was “not the appropriate procedural avenue for such amendments.”³

Submissions

3. In light of the findings in the Chamber’s Decision, the Prosecution now gives notice of the following limited amendments to the Original Request:
 - a. In relation to the analysis of video CIV-OTP-0075-0054 at excerpt 00:11:40 – 00:13:50, at page 2 of Annex B.3 to its Request, the Prosecution withdraws its characterisation of this excerpt as “relevant to the FDS manpower, command and structure”.
 - b. In relation to the analysis of video CIV-OTP-0062-1003, at page 110 of Annex C.1 to its Request, the Prosecution withdraws its reliance on the portion at time stamp 00:21:42 – 00:24:03.
4. The Prosecution is further making two corrections to the Original Request:
 - a. In relation to the analysis of video CIV-OTP-0075-0056 at excerpt 00:01:19 – 00:09:27, at page 9 of Annex B.3 to the Request, the ERN CIV-OTP-0075-0054 is to be corrected to CIV-OTP-0075-0055.
