I. Introduction

III. Applicable Law

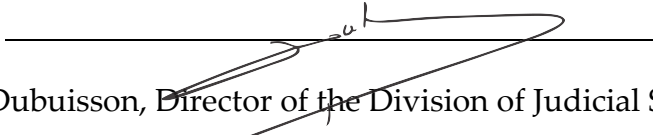

These submissions are made on the basis of article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67, 69 and 73 of the Regulations of the Court (RoC), regulations 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel ("Code of Conduct").

IV. Submissions

4. On 3 April 2018, the Registrar appointed Mr Yasser Hassan as Duty Counsel to represent Mr Al Hassan during his initial appearance before the Court, scheduled on 4 April 2018.¹
