NOTING the instruction of the Chamber, conveyed by email on 16 September 2010, to confidentially disclose to the prosecution and the defence the applications of [REDACTED] after lifting the redactions pertaining to the identity of the victims-witnesses¹ and to review them and report back to the Chamber by 21 September 2010 as to whether additional information which is currently redacted could be disclosed;

NOTING the authorisation of the Chamber² to the Registry to consult the prosecution and the legal representatives of the victim –witnesses on the issue of the redactions and to extend the time by a week to Tuesday 28 September 2010;

CONSIDERING that the Registry has consulted with the prosecution and the legal representative of the victim-witnesses regarding what information pertaining to the identity of the victim-witnesses has already been disclosed;

TRANSMITS to the Chamber the following recommendations:

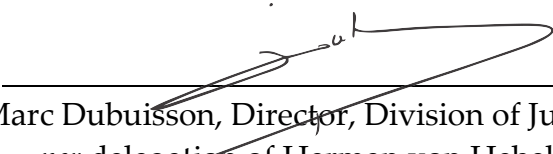
1. In a meeting held on 24 September 2010 with representatives of the prosecution and the legal representative of the victim-witnesses, the Registry received detailed information regarding what information had already been disclosed to the parties in the proceedings.
2. In an email of 24 September 2010, attached as annex 1, the legal representative provided further details of information contained in the applications for participation that had already been disclosed.
3. Having reviewed the information, the Registry considers that only the information already disclosed and no additional information contained in the

applications should be disclosed. Such additional information as is redacted either concerns third parties or the specific whereabouts of the victim-witnesses.

4. The Registry is therefore attaching, as annexes 2, 3 and 4, new proposed redacted versions in which redactions have been lifted on all information that has already been disclosed to the parties.
