I. Introduction

1. The Registry submits this report and its annexes as an update to its "Registry's Updated Report on Solvency of the Convicted Persons" filed on 13 April 2018 ("Solvency Report") as, since then, it received further information from relevant states on the financial situation of Mr. Aimé Kilolo Musamba ("Mr Kilolo") and Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo ("Mr Bemba").¹ Despite the advanced stage of the proceedings, this information may be relevant in the context of the sentencing phase of the proceedings.

II. Classification

2. In accordance with regulation 23bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the annexes are classified as confidential *ex parte* only available to the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") and the two convicted persons respectively, because they contain information on their personal situation.

III. Submission

3. Pursuant to rules 13(1) and 176(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Registry transmits the two following annexes:
 - (a) Confidential *ex parte* Annex I on solvency of Mr Kilolo only available to the Prosecution and Mr Kilolo's Defence; and
