I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Trial Chamber that Mr Anand Ajay Shah (“Mr Shah”), a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court has been appointed as Associate Counsel for Mr Abdallah Banda Abakaer Nourain on 29 June 2018.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annexes II and III are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), as it contains private contact details of Mr Shah.

III. Applicable Law

3. This submission is made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 20 to 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 67 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, articles 5, 7(4) and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 29 June 2018 the Registry formalised the appointment of Mr Shah as Associate Counsel.¹
