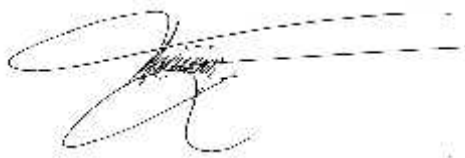

I. INTRODUCTION

1. Following the Single Judge's 'Decision on Defence Request to Add 14 Items to its List of Evidence'¹ and 'Decision on Defence Request to Add 79 Items to its List of Evidence',² the Defence hereby submits its first updated list of evidence (Annex A).
