I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber that Mr Mathias Barthelemy Morouba was appointed by Mr Alfred Yekatom (“Mr Yekatom”) as Counsel to represent him in the proceedings before the Court. The appointment has been acknowledged by letter dated 19 November 2018, following Counsel’s acceptance of the appointment.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annexes I, II and IV are classified as public, whereas Annex III hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains private contact details of Mr Mathias Barthelemy Morouba.

III. Applicable Law

3. These submissions are made on the basis of article 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of the Regulations of the Court (RoC), regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11, 5 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code of Conduct”).

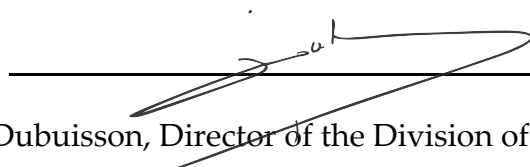
IV. Submissions

4. On 19 November 2018, Mr Yekatom appointed Mr Mathias Barthelemy Morouba as Counsel.¹ On that same day, Mr Morouba accepted the mandate, as required by article 11 of the Code of Conduct.²
5. On 19 November 2018, the Registry officially formalized the appointment of Counsel.³
