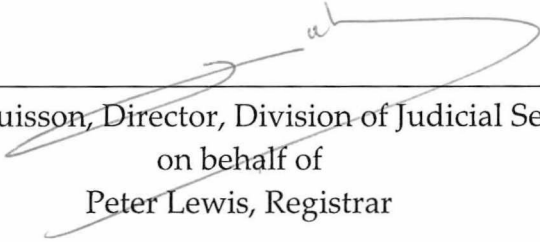

1. On 19 December 2018, Judge Tomoko Akane, Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II, ordered the Registry to “conduct a French language proficiency assessment of Yekatom and submit a report to the Chamber no later than Friday, 28 December 2018.”¹
