Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber II that Ms Mylène Dimitri (“Ms Dimitri”), a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”) has been appointed as Associate Counsel for Mr Alfred Yekatom to represent him in proceedings before the Court. The appointment has been formalized by letter dated 18 January 2019.

I. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annex II are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), as it contains private contact details of Ms Dimitri.

II. Applicable Law

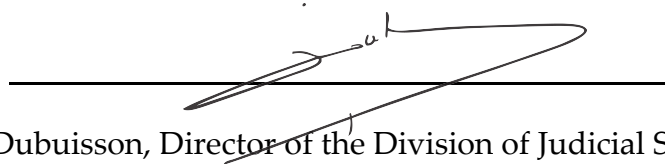

These submissions are made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of the RoC, regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11, 5 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

III. Submission

4. On 18 January 2019 the Registry formalised the appointment of Associate Counsel.¹
