## I. Introduction

1. In paragraph 59 of the Decision Establishing the Principles Applicable to Victims' Applications for Participation ("First Decision")<sup>1</sup>, the Single Judge ordered the Registry to transmit to the Chamber "on a rolling basis and in unredacted form all complete applications and any supporting documentation in its possession."<sup>2</sup>

## II. Procedural History

2. On 17 September 2018, the Registry transmitted 20 applications to the Chamber under the classification of "Group A"<sup>3</sup> (applicants who clearly qualify as victims) ("Group A") and a further 14 applications under the classification of "Group C" (applicants for whom the Registry could not make a clear determination for any reason).<sup>4</sup>
3. On 6 November 2018, the Registry transmitted a further 74 applications to the Chamber under the classification of Group A.<sup>5</sup>
4. On 25 January 2019, the Registry transmitted a third batch of 83 applications to the Chamber under the classification of Group A<sup>6</sup> and 15 applications under the classification of Group C.<sup>7</sup>

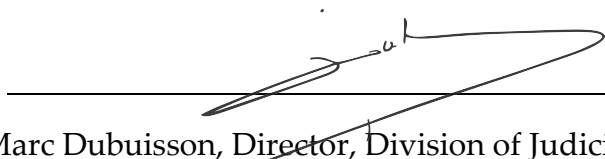
