I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber II that Mr Geert-Jan Alexander Knoops was appointed by Mr Patrice-Edouard Ngaïssona (“Mr Ngaïssona”) as Counsel to represent him in the proceedings before the Court. The appointment has been acknowledged by letter dated 15 February 2019, following the counsel’s acceptance of the appointment. This appointment replaces the previously appointment of Mr Eric Plouvier as Counsel.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annex, I, II and IV are classified as public, whereas Annex III hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains private contact details of Mr Knoops.

III. Applicable Law

3. This submission is made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of RoC, regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11, 5 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

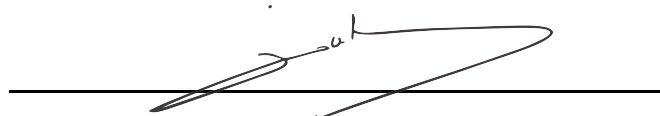
IV. Submission

4. On 14 February 2019, Mr Ngaïssona appointed Mr Geert-Jan Alexander Knoops as Counsel.¹ On 15 February 2019, Mr Knoops accepted the mandate, as required by article 11 of the Code of Conduct.²

5. On 15 February 2019, the Registry officially formalized the appointment of Counsel.³
6. Mr Knoops had previously executed the solemn undertakings as required by the Code of Conduct, which remain valid throughout the proceedings before the Court.⁴
