The Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Court,

In the appeal of Mr Dominic Ongwen against the decision of Trial Chamber IX entitled ‘Decision on Defence Motions Alleging Defects in the Confirmation Decision’ of 7 March 2019 (ICC-02/04-01/15-1476),

Having before it the ‘CLRV’s Request for an Extension of Time Limit’ of 31 May 2019 (ICC-02/04-01/15-1529-Conf)

Renders pursuant to regulation 35(2) of the Regulations of the Court, the following

DECISION

The time limit for the filing of further submissions in this appeal is extended to 16h00 on Monday, 3 June 2019.

REASONS

1. On 24 May 2019, the Appeals Chamber invited the parties and participants to file additional observations on four issues.¹
2. On 31 May 2019, the Victims filed the ‘CLRV’s Request for an Extension of Time Limit’ seeking an extension of the time limit for the filing of their additional observations on the issues identified by the Appeals Chamber to Monday, 3 June 2019.² The Victims do not oppose the same extension being granted to Mr Dominic Ongwen (‘Mr Ongwen’) and the Prosecutor.
3. Pursuant to regulation 35(2) of the Regulations of the Court, a Chamber may extend or reduce a time limit if good cause is shown.
4. In light of the reasons provided by the Victims, the Appeals Chamber considers that good cause has been shown warranting a time extension for the filing of further

submissions in this appeal. The Appeals Chamber considers it appropriate in the circumstances to equally extend the time limit for the filing of further submissions to Mr Ongwen and the Prosecutor. Accordingly, the Appeals Chamber determines that the time limit for the filing of further submissions in this appeal is extended to 16h00 on Monday, 3 June 2019.
