I. Introduction

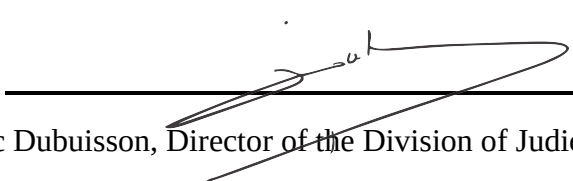
1. The Registry hereby informs Pre-Trial Chamber II that Ms Mylène Dimitri, a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”) was appointed by Mr Alfred Yekatom as Counsel to represent him in proceedings before the Court. This appointment replaces the previous appointment of Mr Stéphane Bourgon as Counsel.

II. Applicable Law

2. These submissions are made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of the Regulations of the Court, regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11, 5 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“the Code”).

III. Submissions

3. On 7 August, Mr Yekatom appointed Ms Dimitri as Counsel.¹ On that same day, Ms Dimitri accepted the mandate, as required by article 11 of the Code.²
4. Ms Dimitri has previously executed the solemn undertaking as required by the Code, which remains valid throughout the proceedings before the Court.³
