I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding the disclosure of evidence pursuant to article 61(3)(b) of the Statute and the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II’s Decision on Disclosure and Related Matters.¹

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as “Confidential” as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 7 August 2019, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Alfred YEKATOM and Patrice-Edouard NGAÏSSONA a total of 237 items of evidence upon which the Prosecution intends to rely, 31 items of evidence that fall under article 67(2), and 12 items of evidence that fall under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence. These items are listed in the Confidential Annex.
