I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding the disclosure of evidence pursuant to article 61(3)(b) of the Statute and the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II’s Decision on Disclosure and Related Matters.¹

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as “Confidential” as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 3 September 2019, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Alfred YEKATOM and Patrice-Edouard NGAÏSSONA 96 items in INCRIM Package 23, comprising screenings of Witnesses on whose Statements the Prosecution intends to rely. As such, the screenings are disclosed as INCRIM, although the Prosecution does not intend to rely on them for the purposes of the Confirmation Hearing. These items are listed in the Confidential Annex.
