## **I - Introduction**

1. Following Trial Chamber IX (“Chamber”)’s “Decision on Defence Request to Add D-0157 to its List of Witnesses”,<sup>1</sup> the Registry hereby transmits documentation in relation to the prior recorded testimony of witness D-0157.

## **III - Submission**

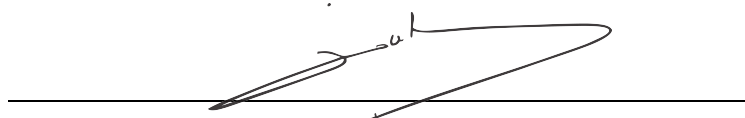
