I. SUBMISSIONS

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") hereby submits its proposals as to the redactions to be applied to the Pre-Trial Chamber ("Chamber")'s Decision on the confirmation of charges against Alfred Yekatom and Patrice-Edouard Ngaïssona ("Confirmation Decision"),¹ as ordered by the Chamber in that same decision.²

2. The Prosecution annexes at Confidential Annex A a copy of the Confirmation Decision, highlighted to indicate the redactions it proposes to ensure the safety and security of victims and witnesses pursuant to Article 68(1), Rule 81(2) and Rule 81(4).
