I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber that Mr Essa Mbye Faal (“Mr Faal”), a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”) has been appointed as Counsel for Mr Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi (“Mr Gaddafi”) on 6 January 2020. Mr Faal was previously associate counsel for Mr Gaddafi.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annex II are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23 bis(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), as it contains private contact details of Mr Faal.

III. Applicable Law

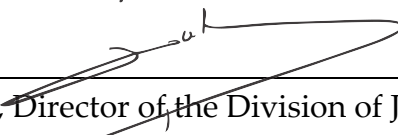
3. This submission is made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 20 to 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 67 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5 and 7(4) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 9 January 2020 the Registry formalised the appointment of Counsel.¹
