I - Introduction

1. On 6 May 2020, Trial Chamber V (“Chamber”) issued its “Decision on the Prosecution’s Request to Designate a Person Authorised to Witness a Declaration under Rule 68(2)(b) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence” (“Decision”).¹
2. In the Decision, the Chamber instructed the Registry to file, in the record of the present case, the standardised forms the Registry has developed for the declarations accompanying prior recorded testimonies of witnesses pursuant to rule 68(2)(b) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”).²

3. In accordance with regulation 23*bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the annex to the present submission is classified confidential because it is an internal work product of the Registry.

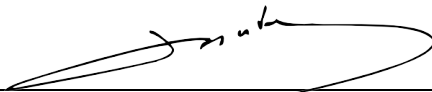
