The Appeals Chamber of the International Criminal Court,

In the appeal of Mr Alfred Yekatom against the decision of Trial Chamber V entitled ‘Decision on the Yekatom Defence’s Admissibility Challenge’ of 28 April 2020 (ICC-01/14-01/18-493),
