## I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this Communication Report regarding the disclosure of evidence.

## II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as “Confidential” as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

## III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 6 November 2020, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Alfred YEKATOM and Patrice-Edouard NGAISSONA Pre-Trial INCRIM package 61 containing 77 items, and Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 20 containing 29 items. All 106 items are subject to the Prosecution’s Request for Non-Standard Redactions to Call Data Records Relating to Seleka Investigation (“Request”).<sup>1</sup> As noted in the Request,<sup>2</sup> these items are disclosed to the Defence with the redactions sought already applied, pending Trial Chamber V’s decision.
