I. NOTIFICATION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this Communication Report regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annex, appended to this filing, is classified as "Confidential" as it relates to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. DISCLOSURE OF EVIDENCE

3. On 22 January 2021, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Alfred YEKATOM and Patrice-Edouard NGAISSONA Pre-Trial INCRIM Packages 78 through 83 containing 4760 items. All but two (4758) are meta-data files concerning previously disclosed photographs and videos.¹ These items are listed in the Confidential Annex.
