I. NOTIFICATION

1. Pursuant to Decision 1763, the Defence for Dominic Ongwen ('Defence') hereby notifies Trial Chamber IX, Prosecution and Legal Representatives through this filing of the attestation forms for the following witnesses and organisations pursuant to Rule 68(2)(b) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
2. The attestation forms are as follows:
 - a. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1889, Report as an Expert Witness at the Sentencing of Mr Ongwen Dominic at the International Criminal Court (ICC) at The Hague: By Major (Retired) Awich Pollar (Confidential Annex A);
 - b. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1812, Where does conviction and sentencing of Dominic Ongwen Leave the Acholi Society? (Confidential Annex B);
 - c. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1878, Report for Sentencing Mitigation, (Confidential Annex C);
 - d. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1901, Ker Kwaro Acholi (KKA) submission to the ICC following the judgement on the Dominic Ongwen case on Feb/4/2021 (Confidential Annex D);
 - e. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1835, Expert report on the LRA's cosmological space. (Confidential Annex E);
 - f. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1833, Dominic Ongwen – At the International Criminal Court – What Sentence (Confidential Annex F); and
 - g. Attestation forms for UGA-D26-0015-1907, Paper on Dominic Ongwen Sentencing Mitigation (Confidential Annex G).
3. The Defence also files the practising certificates for the public notaries used in Uganda Confidential Annexes H.
4. The Defence is currently in the process of having the statement of D-0163, Rwot Baptist Latim, and the Acholi Religious Leaders Peace Initiative notarise, but because of the limitations with

securing a public notary in Gulu, Uganda, the Defence requested an extension to submit those attestations to 13 April 2021.

5. The Defence also notes that it was given an extension to file the attestation forms for D-0008, D-0009, D-0161 and D-0162 until 13 April 2021 due to the unfortunate death in Mr Ongwen's family recently.
6. The Defence files these confidential as they contain personal information of the witnesses not available to the public. Public redacted versions shall be filed contemporaneously.
