I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber II that Ms Katharina Lewis, a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”), has been appointed as Associate Counsel in the team of the joint Legal Representatives of the Victims. The appointment has been formalized by letters dated 21 April 2021 and 28 April 2021.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and Annex II hereto are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23 *bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains private contact details of Ms Lewis.

III. Applicable Law

3. These submissions are made on the basis of articles 43 and 68 of the Rome Statute, rule 21(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of the RoC, regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11 and 5 of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submission

4. On 21 April 2021, the Registry formalised the appointment of Associate Counsel. On 28 April 2021, the Registry issued a corrected version of the letter of appointment of Associate Counsel.¹
