I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs Trial Chamber III that Ms Suzana Tomanovic, a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”), has been appointed as Associate Counsel for Mr Paul Gicheru (“Mr Gicheru”) to represent him in proceedings before the Court. The appointment has been formalized by letter dated 21 July 2021.

II. Classification

2. Annex I to the present submission is classified as confidential in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains personal information of Ms Tomanovic.

III. Applicable Law

3. The following provisions are of particular relevance to the present submission: articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 5, 11 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 21 July 2021, the Registry formalised the appointment of Ms Tomanovic as Associate Counsel.¹
