I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Prosecution hereby notifies Trial Chamber I (“Chamber”) of the disclosure of evidence pursuant to articles 64(3)(c) and 67(1)(a) and (b) of the Rome Statute, and rule 76(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”).

II. CLASSIFICATION

2. This filing is classified as public with one confidential Annex. The Prosecution classifies Annex A as confidential since it contains a list of evidence that has been disclosed to the Defence and contains confidential information.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 18 August 2021, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence Pre-Trial INCRIM package 68, consisting of nine items (46 pages) that have been identified as containing incriminating evidence. These items, including the statements, are related to Witnesses DAR-OTP-P-0955 and DAR-OTP-P-0907.
4. With respect to redactions, the Prosecution applied “standard” redactions as stipulated in the procedure for exceptions to disclosure that was adopted in this case by the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II on 17 August 2020.¹ These redactions are minimal and affect neither the substance of the material nor the ability of the Defence to comprehend it.
