1. The Trial Chamber I (the ‘Chamber’) scheduled the Second Status Conference on 12 November 2021.¹
2. On 3 November 2021, the Defence and the Prosecution filed submissions suggesting items for the agenda.²
3. Accordingly, the agenda for the Second Status Conference is as follows:
 - A. Update on the situation in Sudan and Court’s activities
 - B. Victims’ participation:
 - (1) the victims participation form
 - (2) the ABC Approach
 - C. Trial Witnesses
 - (1) List of witnesses
 - (2) Expert witnesses
 - (3) Applications pursuant to Rule 68 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the ‘Rules’)
 - (4) Protocol relating to contacts with witnesses and victims by another party or participant
 - D. Trial preparation:
 - (1) Agreed facts under Rule 69 of the Rules
 - (2) Trial brief
 - (3) Inadmissibility of witness statements³
 - E. Page limit for filings
 - F. Possible dates for the next status conference⁴
4. A representative of the Registry must be available to attend the status conference and address in particular items A and B of the agenda.

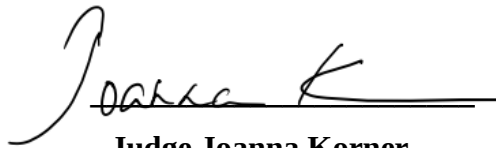

6. The Registry and the parties are to indicate whether any of the agenda items above must be dealt with in private or *ex parte* session.

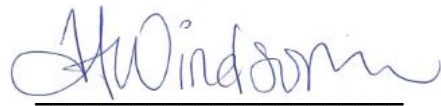
