I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as “Confidential” as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 20 January 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani “Pre-Trial INCRIM package 047” containing 176 items and “Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 022” containing 127 items.

4. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial INCRIM package 047” consists of materials relevant to the “*Union des forces démocratiques pour le rassemblement*” (UFDR) and the “*Convention des Patriotes pour la Justice et la Paix-Fondamentale*” (CPJP) and includes media articles, maps, NGO reports, email exchanges, agreements and international organisation reports, which are relevant material to Chapeau elements of articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute.

5. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 022” consists of materials relevant to the UFDR and the CPJP and includes governmental documents, Facebook messages, media articles, audio and video material, agreements, NGO reports and international organisation reports, which are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence.
