I. Introduction

1. The Registry informs Trial Chamber I (“the Chamber”) that Mr Anand Shah, a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court (“Court”) has been appointed as associate counsel to the team of Legal Representative of the Victims in the present case. The appointment has been formalised by letter dated 17 January 2022.

II. Classification

2. The present submission and its Annex II are classified as public, whereas Annex I hereto is classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as it contains private contact details of Mr Shah.

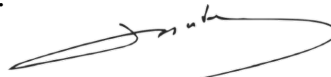
III. Applicable Law

3. These submissions are made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis* and 67 of the RoC, regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry and articles 11, 5 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 17 January 2022, the Registry formalised the appointment of Mr Shah.¹

5. Mr Shah has previously executed the solemn undertakings as required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code.²
