I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as "Confidential" as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 10 February 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 048" containing 31 items, "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 023" containing 13 items and "Pre-Trial Other package 003" containing 14 items.

4. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial INCRIM package 048" consists of materials relevant to Chapeau elements of articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute. Included are media articles, reports by international organizations, an investigation report and French translations of disclosed witness statements.

5. The disclosure of "Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 023" consists of materials relevant to the Seleka as a coalition and an organisation, which are deemed material to the preparation of the Defence. Included are media articles, reports and email exchanges.

6. The disclosure of Pre-Trial Other package 003" consists of materials related to the Seleka and the Anti-Balaka, as well as the French translation of a previously disclosed witness statement. These documents are provided out of an abundance of caution and for the sake of completeness and under the classification of "Other" as

they do not obviously include information material to the preparation of the Defence under rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.
