I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Office of the Prosecutor (“Prosecution”) submits this communication regarding the disclosure of evidence.

II. CONFIDENTIALITY

2. The Annexes, appended to this filing, are classified as “Confidential” as they relate to evidence disclosed *inter partes* that should not be released to the public.

III. SUBMISSIONS

3. On 3 March 2022, the Prosecution disclosed to the Defence of Mahamat Said Abdel Kani “Pre-Trial INCRIM package 051” containing 22 items, “Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 025” containing 50 items, and “Pre-Trial Reclassification to INCRIM package 001” containing 3 items.

4. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial INCRIM package 0051” consists documents from CAR Prime Minister’s Office (Primature) collected by the Prosecution, victim complaints and witness documents which are relevant to OCRB as well as for aspects of the chapeau elements of articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute that are classified as incriminatory evidence. This package contains decrees, legislation, press articles, victim complaints and documents related to witnesses P-1519, P-0468, P-1637, P-1399, P-0349 and P-2490.

5. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial Rule 77 package 025” consists of materials classified as Rule 77 relevant to OCRB and Chapeau elements of articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute that are also deemed material to the preparation of the Defence. This package contains reports, press articles, mission orders, letters, lists, victim complaints and documents related to witnesses P-0349, P-1307, P-1310, P-1305, P-1639, P-1468, P-1703, P-1954, P-2055, P-2103, P-0100, P-1339, P-2489, P-1076, P-2996 and P-1521.

6. The disclosure of “Pre-Trial Reclassification to INCRIM package 001” consists of a video, its transcript and translation previously disclosed as Rule 77, now re-classified as INCRIM.
